We'd like to learn more about the needs of African American cancer survivors and cancer caregivers (*Caregivers are unpaid loved ones who give the person with cancer physical and emotional care. They may be spouses, partners, family members, or close friends. Most often, they are not trained for the caregiver job. Many times, they may be the lifeline of the person with cancer.*).

You are eligible to participate in the **SURVIVOR** focus group if...

- You identify yourself as an African American cancer survivor,
- You received a cancer diagnosis in the past 5 years,
- You have a caregiver now or have ever had a caregiver who helped you after your cancer diagnosis,
- You currently live in the metro Detroit area, and
- You are 18 years of age or older.

You are eligible to participate in the **CAREGIVER** focus group if...

- You self-identify as African American,
- You are currently a caregiver for an African American cancer survivor or have cared for an African American survivor in the last 5 years,
- You currently live in the metro Detroit area, and
- You are 18 years of age or older.
